'Villa Conchi Brut Selección'

A blend of 30% Xarel, 30% Parellada and 30% Macabeo, supplemented with 10% Chardonnay, adding further to the wines' fruit character and the elegance. Grapes are harvested at night all with the aim of maintaining the finished wines' colour, aromas and delicacy. The wine is aged for 12 months, underground in the cellars, prior to release. It was named in the Wines from Spain Awards top 100 wines.

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut I Champagne I France - £69 Length, freshness, balance, elegance, and lightness. The nose is delicate, fine, and complex. Notes of green apple and vine peach bring a fruity touch. Nice roundness on the palate with long and refreshing finish. (VE) BIN 316

Joseph Perrier Organic I Champagne I France - £89 Aged for a minimum of three years, this vivacious champagne has a delicate nose of green apples and stone fruits. A lively freshness balances the round and elegant citrus fruit on the palate. (VE) BIN 314

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut | Champagne | France - £98

Perrier Jouet Grand Brut was first created in 1846 and Herve Deschamps is only the 7th Cellar Master to take the reins and continue the consistency of this delicate, elegant, and beautifully balanced Champagne. Red grapes dominate with 45% Pinot Noir and 25% Pinot Meunier which deliver flavours of white cherry, ripe apricot, pickled ginger, and honeyed notes. Beautifully presented, Perrier Jouet always enhances a celebration. (V) **BIN 301**

Pol Roger Brut NV I Champagne | France - £95

A powerful and aromatic wine with aromas of pear and mango, followed by honeysuckle, white jasmine, vanilla, and brioche. On the palate the wine has mouth-watering freshness combined with flavours of cooked fruit and acacia honey. (VE) **BIN 306**

R' de Ruinart I Champagne I France - £120

Delicate yellow in colour, there are golden glints and a crystalline brilliance. Lush pear, apple and blossom aromas combine with notes of hazelnut and almond. R de Ruinart is rounded, full bodied and balanced, with flavours of greengages and nectarines. The finish is long and fresh as the chardonnay shines through. (VE) **BIN 309**

Taittinger Brut Magnum | Champagne | France - £149

Sourced primarily from Taittingers' Grand and Premier Cru vineyards situated in the three main regions, equal proportions of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir contribute to the blend. Lively, with a fine mousse and an elegant biscuity finish. (VE) **BIN 313**

Taittinger Prelude | Champagne | France - £115

A champagne made from 50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Noir. It has floral aromas and flavours of green fruit, citrus and stone fruit with toasty complexity. It is aged for a minimum of 5 years. (VE) **BIN 302** Ayala Blanc de Blancs I Champagne I France - £145 Striking, voluptuous and vibrant, with a delicate nose of pomelo, white fruit, and frangipani flowers. Perrier-Jouët Blanc de Blanc I Champagne I France - £152

Enticing aromas of hedgerow flowers – elderberry, acacia, and honeysuckle – and tangy citrus. On the palate, its mineral freshness lingers into a surprisingly smooth, mellow finish. (V) **BIN 305**

Ruinart Blanc de Blancs I Champagne I France - £150 Luminous, with subtle green glints and a persistent stream of fine bubbles. Fresh fruits, dominated by bright citrus fruit and pineapple, are mixed with notes of spices and white flowers, such as jasmine. Supple and full-bodied characteristics give way to a clean, pure, and welldefined palate. Refreshing finish of white peach. (VE) BIN 308

Marconnets shows the intensity and power that one might expect from a wine from this end of the appellation. Alt has an intense high-toned nose which shows ripe red fruits and notes of smoke. The palate shows depth with blackcurrant and blackberry fruit and notes of truffle and leather. (VE) **BIN 140**

Bourgogne Pinot Noir - Couvent des Jacobins Louis Jadot I Burgundy I France - Bottle £55 75cl 1/2 Bottle £27 Selected from different villages of the Côte d'Or and Côte Chalonnaise, 25% of the blend is matured in oak. This wine reflects the Louis Jadot style, being silky textured yet full of plump fruitiness. (VE) BIN 159 Bottle or BIN 160 ½ Bottle

Brunello - Fattoria Dei Barbi Di Montalcino I Tuscany I Italy - £98 Deep, rich, savoury aroma of wild cherries over a complex medley of dried Provençale herbs, peppery spice, cocoa and dried fruits of cranberry and black cherry. Succulent and velvet-textured, it is beautifully-balanced with fruit and herby-spicy complexity. Aged in French and Slovenian oak for two years and rested in bottle prior to release. (VE) BIN 103

Château La Fleur de Boüard | Bordeaux | France - £75

This chateau was purchased in 1998 by Hubert de Boüard de Laforest, internationally renowned winemaker and co-owner of Château Angélus. A rich and beautifully full-bodied wine with aromas of blackberry, blueberry and vanilla. Well sculpted with floral notes and velvety tannins. BIN 104

Chianti - Gabbiano Classico Riserva DOCG I Chianti I Italy - £35 A smooth, full-bodied Italian red wine made from the classic Tuscan red grape Sangiovese. This wine has tart dark cherry and violet notes, cigar box and lots of juicy acidity that goes so well with food. BIN 100

Chianti - Riserva, "Antica Cinta" Piccini I Toscana I Italy - £22.50 *Produced from small, selected parcels of Chianti, this is a smooth, elegant and velvety wine, with powerful aromas of ripe cherry, hints of spice and woody notes. Soft tannins and long finish. (VE)* **BIN 153**

Margaux - Château Carreyre | Bordeaux | France - £85

Elegance, finesse and purity typical of the Margaux AOC. Fruit-driven and pure, with a mix of mulberry, redcurrant, and damson plum notes, laced with espresso-tinged toast and backed by light savoury hints on the finish. The 60% new wood barrels bring complexity. (V) **BIN 167**

Merlot I Cabernet - Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona Ateo Sant'Antimo DOC I Tuscany I Italy - £42.50

Ateo, meaning "atheist," was first produced in the 1989 vintage. In this vintage, Ciacci decided not to produce a Brunello di Montalcino. God hadn't blessed them with good Sangiovese for it. **BIN 101**

Morgon Château des Jacques - Domaine Louis Jadot Burgundy I France - £42.50

Louis Jadot own about 35 hectares of south to south-east facing Morgan vineyards on the slopes over the village of Villié Morgon. Generously intense aromas of fresh cherries and apricot richness with a ripe mouthfilling robustness. A classic Cru Beaujolais from one of the top villages. (VE) **BIN 147**

Rioja - Altos Ibéricos Crianza, Torres I Rioja I Spain - £26 The nose reveals ripened black fruits and aromas of cocoa and nutmeg, the silky palate combines creamy blackberry with spicy oak notes. (VE) BIN 142

Rioja - Vivanco Crianza I Rioja I Spain - £29.50

Made from 100% Tempranillo which is aged for 12 months in oak barrels prior to further ageing in the bottle. A deep cherry-red colour, on the nose it reveals notes of ripened black fruits and aromas including cocoa and nutmeg from the oak, it has a silky palate which combines creamy blackberry flavours with the spicy oak notes. (VE) **BIN 149**

Sangiovese - Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona I Tuscany I Italy - £55 A harmonious style, whose graceful frame is enhanced by strawberry, cherry, graphite and tobacco flavours. Intense and long, with plenty of energy on the finish. An example of how special Tuscan Sangiovese really is. BIN 102

Passito - Palazzina Moscato | Piedmont | Italy

A nose of intense lemon curd, marmalade and orange peel with fragrant honeysuckle notes. The palate has lots of ripe apricot and acacia honey characters with toffee apple sweetness. (VE) **125ml Glass £7.95**

Sauternes - Les Garonnelles | Bordeaux | France

An expressive nose with aromas of apricot, ripe pineapple and crème brulée. In the mouth, it is elegant and well balanced, evolving with a long finish full of finesse. (VE) **125ml Glass £9.95**

Louis Jadot source grapes from several of the lesser-known villages of the Côte de Beaune, including notably Chorey-lès-Beaune, which are then vinified and blended under their total control in their own cellars.
